

Catskills Swimming

Dolan's / Hunter Village Lake

Swimming spot set in a park-like setting with picnic tables and a pavilion.

Directions : In Hunter, turn towards Hunter Mountain, then make your first left onto Ski Bowl Road and it is on your left.



Tannersville Lake

Also known as Rip Van Winkle Lake, a popular place to swim. There is a covered picnic area and pavilion. A lifeguard is on duty from 12 noon to 5pm. Swings, slide and basketball hoop.

Directions from Hunter : RT 23A east to Country Route 16. Coming up on your left is the swimming area.



CD Lane Park

Lake Swimming, fishing and boating. Has basketball court, pavilion that is protected from the rain, men's and ladies' bathrooms. Baseball diamond and picnic area is great for families.

Located in: Maplecrest , Just north of Hunter

Directions from Hunter : Scribner Hollow Road North to Rt 23C. Make Left turn on Rt 23C, Make Right on Rt 40. Go thru village of Maplecrest, the park will be on your left side.

North/South Lake

Swimming is permitted at both North and South Lake beaches from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day when lifeguards are on duty. Two picnic areas: one on North Lake with a 20' X 32' picnic pavilion rental and one on South Lake with a 40' X 60' picnic pavilion rental. * Please take note that at facilities that offer swimming beaches, there are days which lifeguards are unavailable. For the safety of our customers, these beaches will not be open and swimming will be prohibited.



Directions from Hunter : RT 23A East thru Tannersville, and then turn north from onto O'Hara Road (County Route 18) in Haines Falls, and go straight ahead, 2.5 miles, to the gate house.

Belleayre Beach

Your place for swimming, boating and summer fun! Belleayre Beach at Pine Hill Lake - a place for the whole family. We offer swimming, picnicking, horseshoe pits, volleyball, basketball, row boat, pedal boat and kayak rentals, fishing and great relaxation!

The Belleayre Beach is open: May 28 - June 11, 2004 weekends only 10:00 am - 6:00 pm. June 12 - September 6, 2004 Weekends and Holidays 10:00 am - 7:30 PM and Weekdays 10:00 am - 6:00 PM



Lifeguards are on duty at all times when the facility is open to the public and swimming is permitted only when lifeguards are present. Swimming outside of the lake's roped area is not permitted.



Directions from Hunter :

Rt 23A East to Rt 214. Make Right Turn onto Rt 214. Take Rt 214 South to Phoenicia. Take Rt 28 West to Highmount, NY. Look for signs for Belleayre.
